### Summary of PPF Spending in Academic Year 2019 -2020

#### **Objectives in spending PPF:**

To support EYPP cohort understanding in relation to Maths Number (EYPP baselines for Number were significantly lower than the cohort in general).

To narrow the attainment gap for EYPP cohort as compared to the remainder of the cohort Through purchase of Story starter books with Maths linked (supporting EYPP children to develop number skills through meaningful and creative contexts)

To purchase open ended mathematical resources to support children's developing number skills through the continuous environment

To support rapid progress for EYPP boys in moving and handling – specific focus fine motor control through dough gym activities.

Group identified through in year progress data and pupil progress meetings

Complete dough gym training with all staff (Literacy Coordinator to lead)

Set up intervention group

#### **Impact**

All staff received dough gym training and finger gym/ dough gym resources and displays in each classroom.

Intervention group established in Summer term 2019 children made outstanding progress in PSE and Numeracy and Literacy. Intervention group supported 8 children to develop fine motor control throughout Spring and Summer terms across both class 3 rooms. Of the 8 children (7 boys/1 girl) to access dough gym all children were working at or above age related expectations by transition to Primary school (88% above and 50% significantly above)
