
No-Freeze Fake Snow Sensory Activity

You Will Need:

- Two clean wide-neck bottles
- · Lining from disposable nappies
- Water (2 cups per nappy)
- · Large container or trough
- · Plastic dinosaur figurines



Method:

- 1. Explain to the children that they are going to create snow that will not freeze their hands.
- 2. Ask children to put on an apron or a smock before starting the activity.
- 3. Encourage children to pull off and out the inner lining of the disposable nappies and scrape out the cottony insides with their fingers. Assist children where necessary.
- 4. Next, assist them in placing the nappy filling into a container.
- 5. Once filled, explain to the children to add water slowly. Make sure they are aware that if they add too much water, they will make sloppy snow.
- 6. Once children are happy with their snow texture, assist children in colouring their 'snow' a colour of their choice. Co-actively help them to drop a few drops of food colouring into the 'snow' and mix around with their hands.
- 7. Encourage them to participate in sensory play, by playing with their dinosaurs in the snow with their peers.
- 8. Explain to the children that if the snow starts to dry out, they can add more water to keep it moist and sloppy.
