Impact

Intervention group established in Spring term 2021 children made good progress towards identified outcomes for individuals. Language intervention group supported 6 children to develop communication skills – focus on understanding of language. Nurture group in the Burrow supporting a group of 5 children to understand and recognise emotions, develop their self-esteem and confidence. 5 children supported through nurture group. This provided a safe environment to complete specific physiotherapy and language programmes.
